Winnipeg MB – July 28, 2010 – The 2010 Manitoba Sports Hall of Fame Inductees include a legendary Blue Bomber lineman, our province's most prolific female golfer, Grey Cup national and provincial champions, and sport builders (including the founder of the Legion Athletic Sport Camps.) On November 6, 2010, four athletes, two builders and two teams will be inducted into the Manitoba Sports Hall of Fame at the 31st Annual Induction Ceremonies.
