

2009 Norman Regional Winter Games

BASKETBALL

AGE CATEGORY:

Adult: 18 years of age and over as of December 31, 2008

ELIGIBILITY:

The following athletes are not eligible to compete:

1. Anyone under the age of 18 years as of January 1, 2009
2. All university (CIAU/college/semi-pro/pro) players signed during the 2006-2007, 2007-2008, 2008-2009 seasons. CIAU eligibility is defined as playing seven or more university games in a given season. Six or fewer games played in a season does not qualify a person as a "CIAU athlete."
3. All players participating in one game of Senior A Provincial Championships during the 2006-2007 and 2007-2008 seasons; or all players currently registered in Divisions 1-3 of the Greater Winnipeg Men's Basketball League.
4. All players participating in the 2008-2009 high school season (MHSAA).

TEAM COMPOSITION:

Male: Minimum eight (8) to a maximum of fifteen (15) players.  
Teams will designate one (1) playing coach from their roster.  
Co-ed teams will not be accepted for competition.

COMPETITION RULES:

All games will be played under the current NCAA Rule System including the following:

1. Games will be scheduled at one and a half hour intervals allowing for a warm up time of 15 minutes for each competition.
2. The game will consist of two (2) twenty (20) minute halves with a ten (10) minute half-time. The team leading at the end of forty (40) minutes will win the game.

3. If the score is tied at the expiration of the second half, the game shall be continued with an extra period of five (5) minutes or with as many such periods of five (5) minutes as are necessary to break the tie.
4. In all extra overtime periods the teams shall continue to play towards the same baskets as in the second half. An interval of two (2) minutes shall be allowed before each extra period. Each extra period will be started by a jump ball at the centre circle.
5. The game time will be momentarily stopped due to an injury.
6. All current NCAA rules changes will apply.
7. The 30-second clock will be in affect. Where there is no 30-second clock available, the referee will count the seconds and at the 10 second mark will indicate verbally there is 10 seconds remaining in the possession.
8. All games will use the size 7 basketball.
9. Dunking will not be permitted at any time.

#### EQUIPMENT:

Uniforms: Teams must provide their own uniforms with numbers for all games

#### OFFICIALS:

Officials must have attended a MABO certified clinic delivered by a MABO certified clinician in 2007-2008.

Officials must have achieved a minimum Level I certification.

#### COMPETITION SITES:

Norway House, MB

#### COMPETITION DATES:

February 20<sup>th</sup>-22<sup>nd</sup>, 2009

#### COMPETITION FORMAT

1. All teams will play in a round robin format and will be guaranteed three (3) games each.
2. Teams may warm up on their designated court before their games provided that another game is not scheduled at that time.

3. Each court is specifically reserved for those teams that have been scheduled to pay.
4. Teams must be prompt in arriving at their designated court at the scheduled time. Games will be forfeited after five (5) minutes of a “no show.” Forfeited games cannot and will not be re-scheduled under any circumstances.

#### TIE BREAKER RULE:

The final pool standings are to be determined by the best win/loss records of the teams. If the teams are tied, the tie will be broken by:

1. The best win/loss record in games involving the tied teams;
2. By the points for/against ratio between the tied teams;
3. By the total points for, only in those games between the tied teams;
4. By a coin toss.

#### MEDALS:

Gold, silver and bronze medals will be awarded to the first, second and their place finishers, respectively.
