Individuals in this category seem to have no limits to the time they will commit to sport. Their energy and enthusiasm and the lasting impact their innovative ideas and strategies are having on sport serve as an inspiration to us all.

Nominations are accepted from Provincial Sport Organizations only. Individuals, Recreation Directors, and sports media are encouraged to contact their PSO directly with suggested nominations. The PSO must endorse each nomination.

One nomination will be accepted per category, per sport. If more than one nomination is submitted in a category from a single PSO, they will be returned and the PSO will be responsible for submitting a single nomination.

Eligibility

- Nominees must be 19 years of age and over as of January 1, 2010.
- Resident of Manitoba for the duration of their contributions to their PSO.
- Nominations should be based upon accomplishments between January 1, 2009 and December 31, 2009, although additional background information will help put that service in context.
- Nominees must act in a voluntary (non-paid) capacity for the PSO.
- The Selection Committee makes its decision based solely on the information you provide. Please assist the committee by ensuring that the nomination is accurate, succinct and complete.
