## **Job Description**

Position: Sailing Instructor Coordinator

#### **General description:**

Appointed by the Board and reporting to the Program Administrator, this position is responsible for organizing and supervising the Summer Sailing Program.

### Specific responsibilities include:

- 1. Assigning and supervising paid instructors, with assurance of their appropriate skills and safety training qualifications/certifications;
- 2. Scheduling instructional groups and instructors;
- 3. Assist with boat set-up, storage and routine care;
- 4. Ensure all lessons are well planned for the week of program;
- 5. Supervise use and maintenance of Club equipment and facilities during the Summer Sailing Program;
- 6. Direct safety measures for all onshore and on-the-water training aspects of the Sailing Program;
- 7. Ensure compliance with legal requirements for youth programs, including completion of coach/instructor checks, and that appropriate supervision, safety measures and parental authorization are in place at all times;
- 8. Other functions and tasks within the above general scope of responsibilities, as assigned by the Program Administrator.
