- Legally entitled to work in Manitoba

### **Job Description:**

The Winnipeg Rowing Club is an inclusive community of athletes, volunteers and coaches, and we are hiring our summer team to deliver rowing programs to the community.

Delivering introductory programming to the sport and developing new athletes is a critical part of our commitment to the sport. Contacting schools and arranging group visits is an important way to grow the sport and spread awareness.

The lead coach's focus is on recruiting, supervision and administration supporting rowing athletes ages 13-17 and adults 18 and over. As part of the coaching team you are responsible for safety, and delivering a training program in line with Sport Canada's Long Term Athlete model. Training athletes for competition includes registration and coaching during regatta events.

Effective shared use of equipment means scheduling ahead of time and respectful coordinating with other coaches.

To ensure a high standard of proficiency in coaching, participation in introductory coaching and safety workshops will be part of your training. This includes accreditation in pleasure craft operation, First Aid, and CPR.
