- Legally entitled to work in Manitoba

### **Job Description:**

The Winnipeg Rowing Club is an inclusive community of athletes, volunteers and coaches and we are hiring our summer team to deliver rowing programs to the community.

Delivering introductory programming to the sport and developing new athletes is a critical part of our commitment to the sport.

This position focuses on recruiting, training and developing athletes ages 13-17 and adults 18+ years. You are responsible to deliver a training program for participants in line with Sport Canada's Long Term Athlete model and ensure athlete safety.

Training athletes for competition includes registering them and managing during regatta events. This position is responsible for introducing rowing to new participants of all ages and backgrounds.

To ensure a high standard of proficiency in coaching, participation in introductory coaching and safety workshops will be part of your training. This includes accreditation in pleasure craft operation, First Aid, and CPR. Mentoring will be provided from experienced coaches.
